Below please find the Fiscal Year 2014 (FY 14) Draft Request for Applications (RFA) for Title II Development Food Assistance Programs in Burundi, Madagascar and Malawi for your review and comments. The documents for FY 14 include the draft RFA itself along with draft country-specific information for the three countries indicated.

As this guidance is draft and subject to change, all potential applicants are strongly advised to wait for final guidance before starting to work on an application. Applications are submitted at the risk of the applicant, and all preparation and submission costs are at the applicant's expense.

- USAID reserves the right to adjust the number of awards, funding levels and sources of funding, given the budget environment and other considerations.
- FFP would greatly appreciate receiving consolidated comments on this draft RFA from the representative groups of the FACG.
